

Frequently Asked Questions

Parking

Where do I park? You can enter the park from A Street. There will be parking volunteers there to direct you.

You can also enter the park from South Street.
There will not be parking volunteers on that side of the Auld building.

Food

Where can I find the food? The food will be located in the food building behind the stage (see map). Coffee and donuts will also be served in the Auld building.

How much does it cost? All of the food is FREE.

Raffle

How much are the raffle tickets? They are only \$1 for each ticket.

The VIP raffle tickets (to be won only by a VIP with Down syndrome) are \$5 each. They are drawing for an iPad mini!

Where do I buy the raffle tickets? Inside the Auld building.

When do you draw for the winners? The winning numbers for the raffle will be drawn and displayed at 9:30am.

Do I have to be present to win? If prizes are not claimed by 10:30am a LIVE second chance drawing will happen on the stage prior to the VIP drawing. You MUST be present to win.

The VIP (or family member) MUST be present to win the VIP drawing.

The Walk will Begin...

When does the walk start? The walk officially kicks off after the singing of the National Anthem, right about 9:30am at the balloon arch. The top two teams (largest number of registered walkers and one for the most money donated) will lead us all down the path.

The other teams will follow in the order as they have lined up.

What do I do after I'm done walking? The walk path will bring you back to the balloon arch.

There the VIP (and any second chance raffle drawings) winner will be announced.

What's with the Team Signs? Each team will have a team sign. This sign will be carried by a volunteer as they lead the teams down the walk path. What a great way to show your team pride. Please return the signs to DSAF at the end of the walk so we may use them again next year.
